

MINUTES OF THE CHURCHES TOGETHER IN SAFFRON WALDEN MEETING

The meeting opened with a reading and prayer.

2. Consideration of the Agenda. Christian Aid. Monthly Prayer Rota. Gazebo.

3. Minutes of last meeting. Minutes of the meeting held on 26 September 2013 were approved and signed.

4. Matters Arising.

(a) Christmas late night shopping. Ged Pearce from the Baptist Church had volunteered to organise this evening, which will be a "VIP Red Carpet" event. Red carpet with chrome posts and ropes loaned from the County High School: personnel formally dressed for the occasion. The idea is to encourage people to enjoy their moment as a VIP and to give the message that "everyone is a VIP to God, so why not join us at a service over Christmas". Ged is providing, at his own expense, "business" cards to be handed out under the CTSW heading, giving the names of all Churches. This Declaration enables Methodist members to retain their own identity, whilst being in association with the URC. **Roman Catholic:** Successful quiz evening held recently. Jenny Tobitt hosted an autistic meeting in Church Hall and so successful a further one planned. **Society of Friends:** Quaker Quest held recently. Wednesday evening meetings closing. **St Mary's:** Christmas Fair 30 November from 9 a.m. – 1 p.m. – 60's theme. Agape Meal 16 January – would like names a week before. **Baptist Church:** Work with Besom continuing. Christmas Fair: 7 December from 2 p.m. 17 December at 7.30 p.m. carol service for East Anglian Children's Hospices. Looking to 2014 with a theme of "discipleship", which could be lent oriented. **Gold Street:** Joint alpha course with Baptist Church. Just held last "Question Service". 9 December 8 p.m. carols and quiz evening at the Old English Gentleman.
